

Rugby for good

It is wonderful to see renewed interest from teams from around the world for an event that has become a fixed date on our annual social calendars. This event also plays a huge role in the 20-year existence of our Scholarship Program. In reaction to the disaster of the 2004 tsunami the ACF Scholarship program was kicked off, with most of the financial support for the program coming from teams who participated in the 2004 Phuket International Rugby Tens.

Since then, the program expanded over the years to also provide scholarship assistance to children from severely disadvantaged families until this year, with more than 493 children sponsored in total so far.

















Impact so far

Ten years ago, the program reached one of its main goals which was a **significant reduction in the dropout rate at age 15**. This was the direct result of the emotional support and guidance provided to the children by our Scholarship team members, but also due to the ongoing financial support that was available to the students.

During the last ten years we have witnessed a definitive change in the focus of students on the program and another of our goals has been reached — ensuring that children on scholarship make it to university to complete their school careers successfully.

Up to now five students have already successfully graduated from university with 16 more students attending vocational college and university this year. The number is growing each year and we are excited to see what come next for these young adults who are entering areas of employment.

Long term partners

Sponsors may have changed over the years, but the consistent support provided by individuals and rugby teams ensured the stability that was crucial for the success of our scholarship students. As we celebrate the 20th anniversary of a program that was born from disaster, but brings hope to many, mere words can never truly and effectively express our thanks, and that of each of the students who have been receiving long term support for their education.

The following teams have been exceptional in their commitment as sponsors throughout the existence of our program and need special mentioning: The Al Ain Amblers, the Asian Japanese Dragons, the Old Bangkok Bangers, the Moorabbin Rams , the Phuket Vagabonds Rugby Club, and both the Singapore Bucks and the Singapore Wanderers all have been sponsoring children's education through ACF for more than 16 years, and are still involved.

Asia Center Foundation's Scholarship Program started in response to the tsunami of 2004. Since then the program has grown and developed and 493 disadvantaged children already have been sponsored with annual sponsorships.

Five students already graduated from university and 16 are attending tertiary institutions to further their education now. All this was made possible by individual sponsors or rugby teams who are participating in the annual Phuket International Elevens Rugby Tournament.

ACF continues to sponsor 120 children in primary, high school, vocational college, and University this year.
















REFEREE'S EXPECTATIONS

- 1) Strict adherence to the Laws of the Games as prescribed by World Rugby
- 2) Yellow/Red Cards
- This will and shall be given out for foul play and repeated individual/team infringements
- For high tackle, we will deal with it as how the Referee sees it. Mitigating factors will be taken into consideration by the Referee officiating the match.
- Red Card suspension is prescribed in the Tournament Guidelines and/or at the discretion of the Main Committee of the Tournament
- 3) Time & Score
- Referees will keep time and score. Running time will be the rule and stopped only if there is a severe injury. This will be done at the next stoppage of play. ie Scrum, Lineout, Free Kick or Penalty. This will be at the discretion of the Referee officiating
- Referees will not stop play unless the injured/fallen player is in the way of the play.
- Doctor and Medics will attend to the same.
- Conversions kicks must be kicked within 30 seconds from the Try was awarded
- Penalty kicks must be kicked within 30 seconds from the time the Team indicated their intention to do so.
- A Restart kick must be taken within 30 seconds from the time of conversion has been taken or declined and/or from the time a penalty goal or dropped kick is kicked.
- 4) Zero Tolerance to Abuse & Foul Play
- -No Excuses
- -No Reasons
- -No Arguments
- Abuse of any Match Official will be an immediate expulsion of the said individual from the tournament

We are looking forward to meeting the teams in Heroes Sports Bar this year.










