The partnership between the Phuket Vagabonds and ACF's children's rugby training program began in 2020 with a shared vision: to use sport as a tool for empowerment and growth. Since then, up to 26 scholarship students (15 boys and 11 girls) across various age groups have taken part in weekly training sessions held at the Alan Cooke Grounds. These sessions are led by dedicated coaches from the Phuket Vagabonds Academy.

This initiative has provided more than just physical training; it has fostered teamwork, discipline, and confidence. The children have shown impressive dedication, attend regular practices and participating in tournaments with great enthusiasm. Notably, the Under-15 girls' team delivered a standout performance last year, demonstrating both talent and determination.



ACF is always seeking meaningful ways to help its scholarship students uncover their potential, and this program has been a fantastic example of that mission in action. We are deeply grateful to the Phuket Vagabonds Academy for their sponsorship and ongoing commitment to our young athletes.

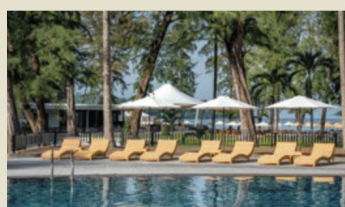
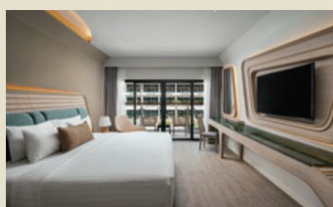
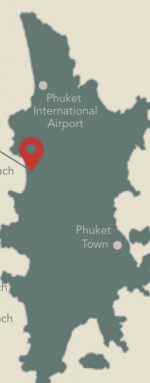

BRISBANE VULGARIANS “MERCENARY HYDRATORS”



Founded in the sultry Brisbane summer of 2008, the Brisbane Vulgarians emerged from a steamy backyard BBQ where rugby, camaraderie, and a touch of mischief collided. Rob “Scrum Daddy” Howe rallied his mates with a bold declaration: “Let’s create a team that plays hard, tackles harder, and isn’t afraid to leave a *lasting impression* on the field.”

From the start, the Vulgarians were anything but conventional. Their first training session involved more oil than a mechanic’s garage, as Coach Sparkles M-man, a former cabaret star turned rugby guru, insisted on “slippery scrums” to build team cohesion. With Sparkles at the helm, the team’s motto became clear: *If you’re going to play dirty, do it fabulously.*

Their special skills sessions, led by the enigmatic player known only as The Fist, were legendary. His unorthodox drills—featuring blindfolds and the occasional safe word—were designed to build trust and “close contact techniques.” The results were undeniable, though opponents often seemed distracted during scrums.

Despite their flair, the Vulgarians struggled to keep up the intensity required of hard off field “players”. By 2025, they shifted focus to a new role: water carriers for other teams. But even here, they left their mark. Opponents are now wary of the Vulgarians’ signature “special” water bottle, often identified by a mysterious layer of cream floating on top.

Today, the Brisbane Vulgarians are a team like no other—part rugby squad, part spectacle, and entirely unforgettable. Just remember: if Sparkles is on the sideline and The Fist is in the stands, you’ve already lost.

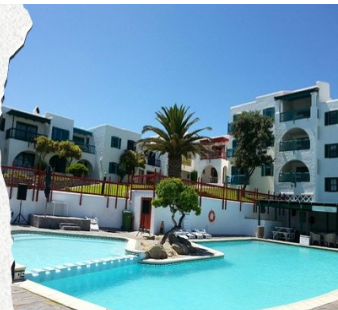

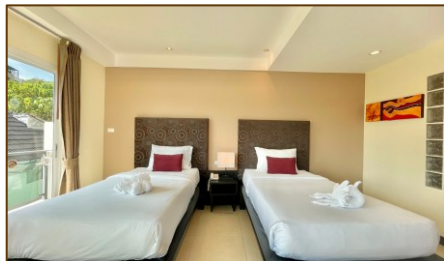

This is his story



Born and raised in Stoke-on-Trent near Manchester, I became a Welsh supporter (English mum, Welsh dad) in my teenage years after hearing the singing at Cardiff Arms Park.

Originally an open side flanker (in my younger, faster days), my favourite player was always Jean Pierre Rives. He was such a flamboyant and exciting player to watch and he always struck me as a non-conformist and, for someone as fiercely independent-minded as myself, that is a very attractive quality. My favourite Welsh players since I started supporting them are probably Jonathan Davies, Bob Norster and Shane Williams, with special mention to Martyn Williams (mostly for having an excellent name but he was also a stellar player) and Gareth Thomas who was a very fine player and I admire him so much for the way he has been so forthright about sexuality and mental health issues, under extremely trying circumstances, thanks largely to the gutter press of The Sun and their ilk.

I first picked up a rugby ball at 9 years old when a new teacher re-introduced the game to our school after a hiatus of many years. After the first session, coming off the pitch muddier than the rest, I knew this was the game for me.

My introduction to club rugby was made by my uncle at 15 or 16 years old, running on for the wing for the local vets team (even though I was a flanker then), never having to put my hand in my pocket and coming home with a bellyful of beer each week.

I was the first player from my club to represent the county colts team in many a year and, using my friends from our school team as a player base, we reignited the club colts' team and enjoyed some local success.



Throughout senior school and whilst studying at Bristol university, I continued to play and enjoy the game, but my life was transformed after I moved to Singapore in 1990. Fortunately, whilst watching the excellent SCC 7's on the Padang two weeks after my arrival, I met the friendly guys & gals from the Bucks RFC and I'd found a new rugby home. The club was very eclectic in those days (as a club, we could order a beer in 24 different languages) with the emphasis very much on the social side of the game. I soon became involved in the organisation of the club as a few of the previous club stalwarts left shortly afterwards.

Recognising my interest in the game, and the fact that I had attended two Singapore Rugby Union (SRU) AGMs in succession, I was, to my complete surprise, nominated as one of the 3 vice-presidents in 1992. The SRU was completely amateur in those days, not so much as an administrator in sight, and I was quickly spotted as the naïve young upstart in the new committee and given the unenviable role of competitions manager, which involved arranging games, booking pitches and referees and dealing with the endless requests from the competing clubs, all whilst learning the ropes at my full-time job.

It was a very tough role but helped me get to know the local rugby scene in a way that would have been impossible otherwise.

Roll forward 28 years and I was, once again, vice-president of the SRU (it was my third term holding the post, as I also held it during the leadership transition during the 2006/07 season).

Singapore rugby has come a long way since those early days and we now have a full-time executive staff who manage all the operational aspects of rugby here and a management committee that is both involved and committed.



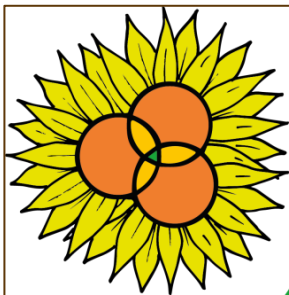
Under the leadership of then president, Terence Khoo, the SRU had re-organised and had spent the previous 3 years defining our objectives and developing policies and processes that would help us achieve them. The first couple of years we were distracted by the challenges of staging the HSBC Singapore Rugby Sevens tournaments but, fortunately, the whole event is now organized directly by Sport Singapore, leaving us time to focus more on our core duty of managing and developing the sport here. To my mind, rugby is currently at a major crossroad, and I believe it cannot survive in its current form. The game has never completely come to terms with professionalism, and the spiraling costs and expectations that professionalism has created has not been matched by increased income (except in a few very limited cases), and sponsorship is increasingly difficult to come by.

After working for 25 years as a construction project manager, I decided to make a huge change in my life and I am now a full-time professional counsellor and have started my own company, Harmony Counselling. The skills I have developed as a counsellor are extremely helpful in providing empathetic, non-judgmental support to those who have experienced harassment or abuse.

Other challenges lay ahead of us, including working with Asia Rugby to develop a clear and consistent international competitions calendar and, subsequently, organizing a more stable domestic rugby calendar. We are making good progress in these areas but there is still some way to go and always the next challenge to focus on beyond that.

As my playing career has now ended (except for the possibility of the occasional over 45s tournament), I am grateful for all rugby has given me over the years and am happy to have the opportunity to do my part in helping the game move forward in a way that embraces the new without losing the essential spirit of friendship and respect, which makes ours such a unique sport.

REFEREE'S EXPECTATIONS



- 1) Strict adherence to the Laws of the Games as prescribed by World Rugby
 - 2) Yellow/Red Cards
 - This will and shall be given out for foul play and repeated individual/team infringements
 - For high tackle, we will deal with it as how the Referee sees it. Mitigating factors will be taken into consideration by the Referee officiating the match.
 - Red Card suspension is prescribed in the Tournament Guidelines and/or at the discretion of the Main Committee of the Tournament
 - 3) Time & Score
 - Referees will keep time and score.
 - Running time will be the rule and stopped only if there is a severe injury. This will be done at the next stoppage of play. ie Scrum, Lineout, Free Kick or Penalty. This will be at the discretion of the Referee officiating
 - Referees will not stop play unless the injured/fallen player is in the way of the play.
 - Doctor and Medics will attend to the same.
 - Conversions kicks must be kicked within 30 seconds from the Try was awarded
 - Penalty kicks must be kicked within 30 seconds from the time the Team indicated their intention to do so.
 - A Restart kick must be taken within 30 seconds from the time of conversion has been taken or declined and/or from the time a penalty goal or dropped kick is kicked.
 - 4) Zero Tolerance to Abuse & Foul Play
 - No Excuses
 - No Reasons
 - No Arguments
 - Abuse of any Match Official will be an immediate expulsion of the said individual from the tournament
 - 5) Decision making
 - the Referee
 - i) may consult the Assistant Referee about any matters relating to foul play
 - li) may alter his decision if he made such a consultation
 - lii) has the power to stop play at any time
 - 6) The Referee is the sole judge of fact and of law during the match
